

COMMON HOUSEHOLD FOODS THAT SHOULD NEVER BE GIVEN TO YOUR CAT OR DOG

PLEASE NOTE: The following foods are toxic or very likely to cause intestinal obstruction to your cat or dog.

If your cat or dog has ingested any of the foods listed, please contact your veterinarian as soon as possible. The earlier you contact your veterinarian the better chance your pet has of survival.

- Grapes
- Raisins
- Garlic
- Chinese chive
- Anything from the garlic (Allium) family
- Macadamia nuts
- Chewing gum with Xylitol
- Onions
- Bones of any type
- Raw bread dough of any type
- Raw fish and bones
- Peaches with the pit
- Any pit or stone fruit
- Chocolate
- Cocoa
- Avocados
- Mouldy cheese
- Nuts
- Alcohol
- Coffee
- Tea
